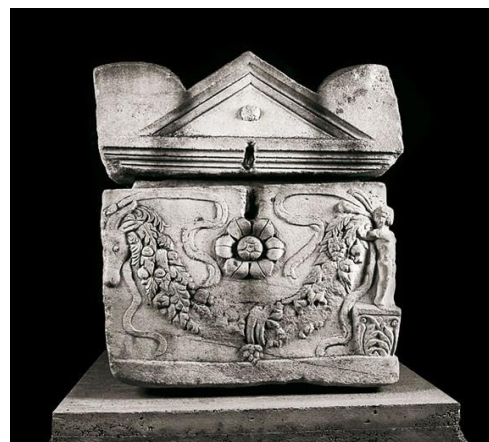
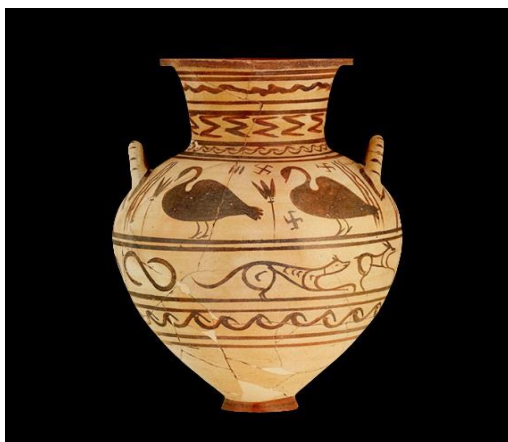
Museums & Places to Explore

2. Daily cruise to Chalkidiki (Price: €68)

3. Vergina and Pella Day Trip from Thessaloniki (Price: € 58 plus museum ticket price)

Explore the imperial capital of Pella, birthplace of Alexander the Great and where Aristotle once tutored him. Uncover archaeological treasures from the Macedonian Kingdom, including those of Philip II, detailed by Herodotus.

Journey through ancient Greek, Byzantine, and modern history, rediscovering the lost prestige of Aigai, the original Macedonian capital and royal necropolis. Visit the UNESCO World Heritage site, the Museum of the Royal Tombs of Aigai.
